BIOGRAPHY OF THE AUTHOR

Veronica Roth was born in New York City on August 19, 1988. She was the youngest of three siblings. His father's name was Edgar Gustave Roth. His mother was a painter who came from Barrington named Barbara Ross. When he was a five year old his father and mother divorced. Then his mother remarried to a financial consultant from Poland named Frank Ross.

She had a hobby of writing. Since she was 11 years old, she loved writing. His hobbies had been proven by all the works she had produced. she went to school at Barrington High School. While still in school he entered a writing competition. Then he continued to study at Carleton Collage. And finally he continued at Northwestern University. She chose the creative writing program while studying. During college he had the idea to launch a novel.

Veronica Roth was best known for her trilogy novels *Divergent*, *Insurgent* and *Allegiant*. His first novel, entitled *Divergent* was a science fiction genre set in Chicago. In this novel entitled she told about the grouping of people based on their nature. In the story there are five factions namely Erudite, Candor, Dauntless, Amity, Abnegation. If there was someone who has more than one nature then he can be said to be a divergent. Then his second work is *Insurgent*. She told the story of Triss's life as the main character. Triss, who was always coming to talk about his life that had been left by his parents. And the third was *Allegiant* that told the Triss's discovery about a new organization that had been controlling his life. The three results of his work became the New York Bestseller. Veronica also managed to get several awards such as Favorite Book of 2011, Best Young Adult Fantasy and Science Fiction 2012 Goodreads, and Best Goodreads Author.

In 2011 she married a photographer named Nelson Fitch. After marriage she lived in Romania. Then she and her husband settled in Edgewater Chicago. Veronica then started a restaurant business with two friends. Her husband also opened a wine and liquor business. He wanted to get a new job besides becoming a photographer. His efforts earned him an award for the liquor and wine he sells for being of high quality. At first Nelson did not have the support of Roth. Roth finally supports Nelson's efforts after seeing his talent and business.

Veronica has its own reasons for writing Divergent stories. The first main character is Four, he changed it to Triss. The character changes on the grounds that the main character is played by a woman who has a strong will and will do anything that can threaten her life. Although a Triss must fight against violence perpetrated by the leader of the Dauntless group such as throwing knives and jumping from tall buildings. In fact, not only that when in the Dauntless Triss hostel always experienced violence committed by the leader of the Dauntless group. Because Veronica considers that women can be strong like men.
