

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION & SUGGESTION

#### 5.1 Conclusion

Based on the research problem, this study is focusing on identifying the language style on twitter. The object data in this research is the status updates of twitter users. From the data collected, the researcher found 40 data that are appropriated with types of language styles that are formal, informal, colloquial, slang, and intimate.

The first type is the Formal style. Formal style is grammatically well-formed and avoids contraction, there are 2 data found in this style. The second type is the informal style. From the data collected, the informal style has 38 data found. This style mostly appearing in twitter status because twitter users more pleasant in expressing their opinion about politics and does not need grammatical word forms. The third type is the colloquial style. Colloquial style is a half of slang style and informal style. This style using contraction and shortened words there are 13 users use this style in writing twitter status. The fourth type is slang style. Slang is the most casual style, commonly used in a speech group of people. The words choice sometimes could be understood only by the people in the groups, there are 8 data in slang style. The last is the Intimate style, this style rarely commons in twitter status especially with the political topic because this style is used only by people who have a very close relationship. There is 1 data of intimate style.

From the five language styles on Joos (1967) theory, the researcher did not found the frozen style and consultative style in twitter status because the frozen style is an oratorical used in a most formal situation and does not change. While consultative style; this style generally used in a speech to response other people in conversation.

## **5.2 Suggestion**

The result of this research does not cover all of the kind of language style at least this research is not the complete one. Hopefully, criticisms and suggestions will rise from the reader to gain the better researcher in the future. The writer wants to give some suggestions for future researchers on language style.

1. The next researcher suggested to taken the data of language style on other kinds of the object of the data source for example: movies, novel, television program, newspaper, etc. Those provide many different situations and topics.
2. Language and style is an interesting subject to be studied, so that the writer suggests that the next researcher can use other theories beside Kriszner and Mandell (1978) and Joos (1967) theory to analyze the phenomenon in sociolinguistic area especially in language and style.
