ABSTRACT: The study is about an analysis of Lenny Samuel's personality which influence his investigation in Philip Prowse's *The Woman Who Disappeared*. The thesis aims to find out Lenny's personality and how it can influence the investigation toward his client. The writer uses qualitative research due to the fact that it provides understanding into the problem and helps to derive meanings from the investigation in the novel. In the research, the analysis is conducted by using psychological approach. Through the novel, the writer finds that Lenny Samuel is a private detective who is gets a job from Helen Garfield. The job is to find her sister who had disappeared a week before she made a report to Lenny. Her sister name is Elaine Garfield and they are twin. Helen asks Lenny to find her sister because she does not want any trouble with the police. ABSTRACT: Penelitian ini tentang sebuah analisis dari kepribadian Lenny Samuel yang mempengaruhi investigasinya dalam *The Woman Who Disappeared* by Philip Prowse. Penelitian bertujuan untuk menemukan kepribadian Lenny dan bagaimana kepribadian itu mempengaruhi investigasi kepada kliennya. In accordance with the above explanation, the writer intends to conduct a research with the object from the text of literary work, a novel entitled *The Woman Who Disappeared* Authorized by Philip Prowse. The novel provides an interpretation of a personality picture of a person who struggles to find out her sister's client from his investigation. The thesis, therefore, will show the analysis of Lenny

Samuel's personality and its influence on his investigation.

Optimistic

³ Being positive all the time. Recovers from anger or sadness very quickly or doesn't feel bad emotions at all. Usually very high spirited or loves to smile. Nad also something is about being positive, ⁸ emotionally intelligent, leader, demonstrate a healthy, positive outlook and display a positive regard for future, optimistic is a powerful force that many overlook (Shankman et. al, 2015:179)

Outgoing is the word meaning simply that one goes out of their way to meet and make new friends. Outgoing can be broken down into two words: Out and going. Outgoing involves people going out of their way to make friends and to be sociable.

Storytellers

A person who writes, tells, or reads stories, someone who simply put.

Humor

Adjective used to describe a funny or humorous entity. Commonly used as a substitute for "funny" in Southern California. Humor is not ephemeral or accident human characteristic, but is grounded in something deeper within our nature or our condition (Amir, 2014; 163)

Forgetful

Forgetful people are often spacy and careless; they're not mindful of what they should be doing. Forgetful are very common, and also mild fear that the mind is going (Chapman, 2003;93)

Enthusiastic

Passion, devotion or eagerness of an occupation, activity, or pursuit in which such interest is shown. Enthusiastic is to be exit about something even passionate (Barsoti and Johnston 1995; 146)

A Worker

A person who works at a specific occupation. Forced to give up part at his life to a power full superior (Cohen, 1995: 146)

Creative

Producing or using original and unusual ideas. Creative is nevertheless quite interesting (Finke, 2014; 4)

Friendly

The act of making friends easily.

Undisciplined

The trait or characteristic of not having discipline, undisciplined person who lets himself or herself go and doesn't care about proper exercise (Hart, 2010: 26)

Adventurous

A word describing someone who looks for that extra something out of life; who is never happy with the standard or normal and always wants to explore a little further. An adventurous person tends to take risks and push the limits of methods or ideas that are considered acceptable as the norm among unadventurous people.

Restless

Unwilling or unable to stay still or to be quiet and calm, because you are worried or bored.

Apologetic

Showing that you feel sorry about having caused someone problems or unhappiness.

Introvert

² Introvert Personality-Introverts are often characterized by their capacity for inward reflection and a need to understand the world before they experience it (Tieger & Barron-Tieger, 1995).

1.3 RESEARCH METHOD

Literary Approach

In this thesis, extrinsic approach is applied to analyze the novel *The Woman Who Disappeared*. This research based on Wellek and Warren (1977: 73), the extrinsic approach is the approach that is out of the text. As the study concerns with personality, the literary approach used is psychoanalytic criticism.

Research Design

In the study, the writer uses qualitative method to observe and analyze the data that obtained in *The Woman Who Disappeared*. According to Bodgan and Biklen (1982:27), qualitative research is descriptive data, which is concerned with

collecting data in the form of words or pictures rather than the number.

Data Source

The data source is a printed book which is written by Philip Prowse, *The Woman Who Disappeared*. The form of the data is the quotations from the novel. The writer selects fourteen data that relate to the topic of the research.

Procedure of Data Collection

In collecting the data, the writer collects the data by reading the novel as the data source. All of the data are taken from the novel Philip Prowse's *The Woman Who Disappeared*. Then, the writer analyze the words, sentences, and expression that related to C. G. Jung Theory.

Procedure of Data Analysis

he ask about partner of work Elaine Garfield to Mr. Myer. Later Mr. Myer recommends Suzy as partner of work Elaine Garfield.

The quotation above, Lenny Samuel's personality is Extrovert. He invites someone to discussion. He wants to know about her sister client. Lenny Samuel needs someone to add information in his investigation.

Characteristic of Lenny Samuel's Personality

Humor

One of the Lenny Samuel's personality is humor. Whenhe meets with his client namedHellen Garfield in his office. When she tries to tell her story of her sister who disappeared to him. But Lenny Samuel gives the funny respond to her. He wants to make her to be relax first. Otherwise his

humor makes her angry because she thinks he doesn't serious in his service of problem as it is seen in the quotation bellow.

¹ My sister disappeared a week ago. We had arranged to have dinner together last Monday night, but she didn't come. Perhaps your sister didn't come because she doesn't the food you cook, I suggested. Don't try to be funny. I flew all the way from New York to see her last Monday, she said angrily. (Prowse, 2003: 8)

After he knows his client doesn't like his humor, he becomes serious. Lenny Samuel begins to collect the information about Elaine Garfield who disappeared. He tries analysis the information that her client gives to him from her story.

Optimistic

As the private detective, Lenny Samuel should be optimistic in what he does. Such as when Helen Garfield tells her worry that her sister in danger, he makes sure to her that no matter is easy or difficult to find her sister who disappeared, he promises will find her as it seen in the quotation bellow.

¹ I am sure that she's in danger and I want find you to find her. All right, I said. It may be easy or it may be difficult, but I'll find her. But first,

tell me why you've waited six days before coming to me. That's none of your business, the girl said. (Prowse, 2003: 9)

After Lenny Samuel makes sure his client. He wants to know a reason why Helen Garfield waits a week days. Her reason will be information to support on Lenny Samuel's investigation. Lenny Samuel doesn't want that information just a common reason. Therefore he gives some questions for

A Worker

Conversation between Lenny Samuel with Helen Garfield. Lenny Samuel identifies his sister client. He wants to know everything about her, so he gives more questions to Helen Garfield. It is can be habit that know more deep about someone who to be target. Everything about Elaine sister must be important for Lenny Samuel. He sinks his egoism for collect information about Elaine Garfield. It isn't just important also, information about Elaine Garfield to be priority.

We're twins easy. No, Mr. Samuel, how much money do you charge? Fifty dollar a day, I said. Very well Mr. Samuel. Said the girl, but fifty dollar a day is a lot of money. I hope that you will work hard for it. (Prowse, 2003: 9)

The quotations above, Samuel is worker. He braves to ask about fee before he does it. A worker is a men or women who changes they are idea, energy and service with fee. It is uses treaty before like Lenny Samuel. He changes his service with money. Lenny Samuel as a worker when his feel to be happy at the moment he listens answer from his client about nominal of fee that will getting after doing it. Automatic the changes of idea, energy or service to be spirit that will adding a worker.

Enthusiastic

Lenny Samuel listens what Helen Garfield tells. She waits for my sister till Monday evening. But she doesn't come. She calls her. But there is no answer. So the next morning, she goes to office where she works. At her office, she has been to work the day beforeon the Monday. Therefore Helen goes round to her flat, but there is no there.

All right, I said, it may be easy or it may be difficult, but I'll find her. But first, tell me why you've waited six days before coming to me. That's none of your business, the girl said. Ok, I replied. Your sister's name is Elaine Garfield. What does she look like? Oh, that's easy, Helen Garfield replied, she looks like me. We're twins. (Prowse, 2003: 9)

The quotations above that, Samuel is enthusiastic. Start to he asks name of her sister client, and identifying about her. Spontaneous Samuel wants to know more deep about her. He also request Apartment and workplace address to her sister client.

Friendly

When Samuel cutting him nails, he hears someone walk into the outer room, there are a very quiet knock on the door of the inner room. The door open and in walk one of the most beautiful women. She does about eighteen years old, with blue eyes and long blonde. Her name is Helen Garfield. She is client of Lenny Samuel.

Excuse me, said the girl. I'm looking for Mr. Samuel. I'm Samuel, I said, with a quick smile. Come in and sit down. The girl didn't smile back at me. No, I won't sit down, she said. (Prowse, 2003: 6).

The quotation above shows, Lenny Samuel is friendly. He as host who give a smile to client candidate, which a smile can as sign of welcome to Helen, he also ask to come in for sit down. It is a something way to get a new friend.

Creative

Someone who is creative if having an idea or opinion to something different and good to problem solve. When Helen comes into the outer room, ¹ it all starte late one afternoon, when he sitting in his office. He just finish cutting his nails and has about to clean them.

I thought that someone had made a mistake and come into the wrong office. It probably someone looking for the doctor next door. But a moment later, there was a very quiet knock on the door of the inner room. Come in, 'I shouted and put away the scissor I had been cutting my nails with. (Prowse, 2003: 6)

The quotation above that, Samuel is creative. He cutting nails with a scissor, the other people usually cutting nail with the cutting nails tool, that available in the pedicure manicure shops. Usually in the office the scissor uses cutting a paper only.

But it is different way, Samuel uses scissor for cutting his nails.

Adventurous

One of Lenny Samuel's personality is Adventurous. The man with the gun starts to laugh. He puts the gun back in his pocket and stop laughing, they are laughing because see Lenny Samuel so stupid. Lenny Samuel replays to stop Jo and his friend. The man is angrily. One of them hit Lenny Samuel's face.

'I must say that I wasn't expecting to be hit in the face, it hurt.

'It hurt even more when he hit again and I tell on the floor.'

'I lay still on the floor, hoping that the two men would go away.'

'But they didn't go away instead, they two pick me up and hit me hard on the head.'

'Everything went black, I lay on the floor, I was unconscious.

(Prowse, 2003: 15)

The quotations above that, Samuel is adventurous. He braves to take risks, whatever that trying to block his investigation. He also doesn't think in the future, in other safety by himself. Because profession as detective, full challenges, especially as private detective.

Undisciplined

The one of Lenny Samuel's personality is undisciplined. Due to his death Benny Greep, Lenny Samuel brings to the police station. He has in question for his death. But Lenny Samuel doesn't answer, because Sergeant Murphy as police asks for Who Lenny Samuel work. Then Sergeant Murphy has let Samuel go. He has orders some policemen to follow Lenny Samuel. Samuel drives straight back to the office.

'The door to the outer room was open, as usual, but the room was empty.'

'Helen Garfield wasn't there.' But there was a letter on the table, on top of the magazines'

'I picked the letter up and read it'

'I put the letter in my pocket and looked at my watch.'

'It was just after six o'clock.'

'I had five and a half hour before the meeting with Helen Garfield'

(Prowse, 2003: 31)

The quotations above that, Samuel is undisciplined. He must come in his office at five o'clock but he comes in there after six o'clock. He lates. The client disappoints whit him. Then she writes a letter for him. She takes up in the magazine.

Talkative

One of Lenny Samuel's personality is talkative. When Lenny Samuel standby in Las Cabanas Club. He waits Helen Garfield. He sits in the table then order a drink. For several minute Helen Garfield comes. She comes with angry face. She walks toward Lenny Samuel then sit in front of Lenny Samuel's chair. Helen Garfield feels angry with Lenny Samuel because he doesn't come in self office so Helen Garfield gives message on paper then puts in front of table. The paper's contents invite for drink in the Las Cabanas Club.

'When the waiter had gone, the beautiful blonde girl said.'

'Come on, Mr. Samuel. Tell me.'

'Call me Len, all my friends call me Len.'

'I am not a friend of yours Mr. Samuel.'

'The blonde girl said, in a voice like ice.'

'I am paying you a lot of money to work for me. '(Prowse, 2003: 38)

The quotations above shows, Lenny Samuel is Talkative. He courtesy the client has been waiting him to talk the news about her sister. The opposite Lenny Samuel tells about something that according to Helen Garfiled that is useless. The client feels

angrily about that. Lenny Samuel should not speak like that. It is make he like arrogant people who feel the best people about his job. The client's tell is true. She as client has worry about her cases. She waiting for progress about the cases. But the Samuel doesn't understand what her feel.

Story Tellers

One of Lenny Samuel's Personality is story tellers. When Lenny Samuel meets with his sister client in the Las Cabanas Club. There they meet to discuss what he has gain after visiting to Elaine Garfield's Apartment in the Manson Building. The Manson Building is guards by unfriendly porter. He will not give any information about someone who live in the Manson Building. He maintains her privacy from foreigners.

Helen Garfield listens Lenny Samuel's story with silence. She understands what has been feel of Lenny Samuel. That story makes Helen Garfield speechless. She does not do anything. Then begin to cry. Therefore Lenny Samuel is Story tellers it seen the quotation bellow.

After that Helen Garfield does know what has been feeling by Lenny Samuel, Hellen Garfiled begins to cry because she doesn't know it will be like this. The story from Lenny Samuel of the loss of Elaine Garfiled tells about the death of Benny Greep which she does not think before.

Forgetful

The one of Lenny Samuel's personality is forgetful. When Sergeant Murphy looks Lenny Samuel straight in the eyes. He hates all private detective specially Lenny Samuel. Sergeant Murphy does not believe Lenny Samuel is telling the truth. So Sergeant Murphy locks Lenny Samuel into the room.

It is one Lenny Samuel's personality, more way to get it, there are from his parent, memory is full to remember something. Many factors affect forgetful, that is due to accident, heredity, mostly mind and because of illness. When view from this novel, Lenny Samuel become forgetful because full memories

Restless

The one of Lenny Samuel's personality is restless. When he keeps quiet follows the older policeman out of the room. The policemen get into Lenny Samuel's car. The policeman drives at the police station. There Lenny Samuel stays in a small room.

But I could not sleep. I was thinking about all the things which had happened since I had met Helen Garfield the day before.

The quotations above shows Lenny Samuel is restless.

When He wants to say to Helen as him client. He cannot sleep with enjoy, maybe it never feel like that cases. He also gets terror from other people which can threaten by himself. Lenny Samuel has worry about that. This should not happen to him.

Apologetic

Lenny Samuel return to his office without anything. The effort that has been done does not produce anything. When Helen Garfield comes to Lenny Samuel's office, she will pay him a fortune to find her sister who is disappear. Because at that time Helen Garfield still has a diamond. But the one that carry of Helen Garfield belong to Jo and his friend, who first meet in Elaine Garfield apartment. They are jewelry raiders who are looking for a lost age, after

being kept at Las Cabanas Club table. The diamond is stolen by Benny Greep. He is boyfriend of Elaine Garfield. Elaine Garfield and Benny Greep are the target of Jo and friend. But the police immediately arrested Jo and friend as a robber as well as a killer Benny Greep. Then carrying his jewelry as evidence.

1.5 CONCLUSION
