





ABSTRACT

This thesis analyzes of oppression on black women in Bernardine Evaristo's Girl, Woman, Other. The problems are: (1) How is the oppression on black women representation in Bernardine Evaristo Girl, Woman Other? (2) What are the causes of oppression on black women in Bernardine Evaristo Girl, Woman, Other? (3) What are the effects of oppression on black women in Bernardine Evaristo Girl, Woman, Other?. The objective of the study is to find reflection of oppression on black women and the cause and the effect of the oppression. In analysis the problem, the thesis writer applies a qualitative method. The thesis writer uses extrinsic approach and psychological approach. The analysis shows that black women experience oppression. The forms of oppression found were discrimination, sexual harassment, racism, verbal abuse, violence, exploitation, and powerlessness. Several causes that make black women experience oppression such as patriarchy, social status, and lack of resources make them experience oppression.
