## **CONCLUSION**

This chapter is a conclusion of what has been discussed in chapter IV. The conclusion is divided into 2 parts. **First**, based on the stop sounds, the sequence of duration that have the longest duration is the sound [d], [g], [t], [p], [b], and [k]. **Second**, based on the data, each data has different duration on each sounds, data 1 (N.A) has median duration in sounds [g], [p], and [k], data 2 (A.G) has the longest duration in sounds [g], and [t], data 3 (A.N) has median duration in sound [d], data 4 (M.B) has the longest duration in sounds [b], the median duration in sound [d] and the shortest duration in sounds [g], [k], and [b], data 5 (D.A) has the longest duration in sounds [d], [p], and [k], the median duration in sounds [b] and [k].
