CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

This chapter concludes the conclusions and suggestions. After analysing social conflict in Linda Castillo's novel *Sworn to Silence*, the writer makes the following conclusions and suggestions:

5.1. Conclusion

Based on the analysis of data on social conflict in Linda Castillo's novel *Sworn to Silence* in the discussion, the study concluded that the types and effects of social conflict occur in the novel as follows:

There are two Violence, three Anger and four Murder.
